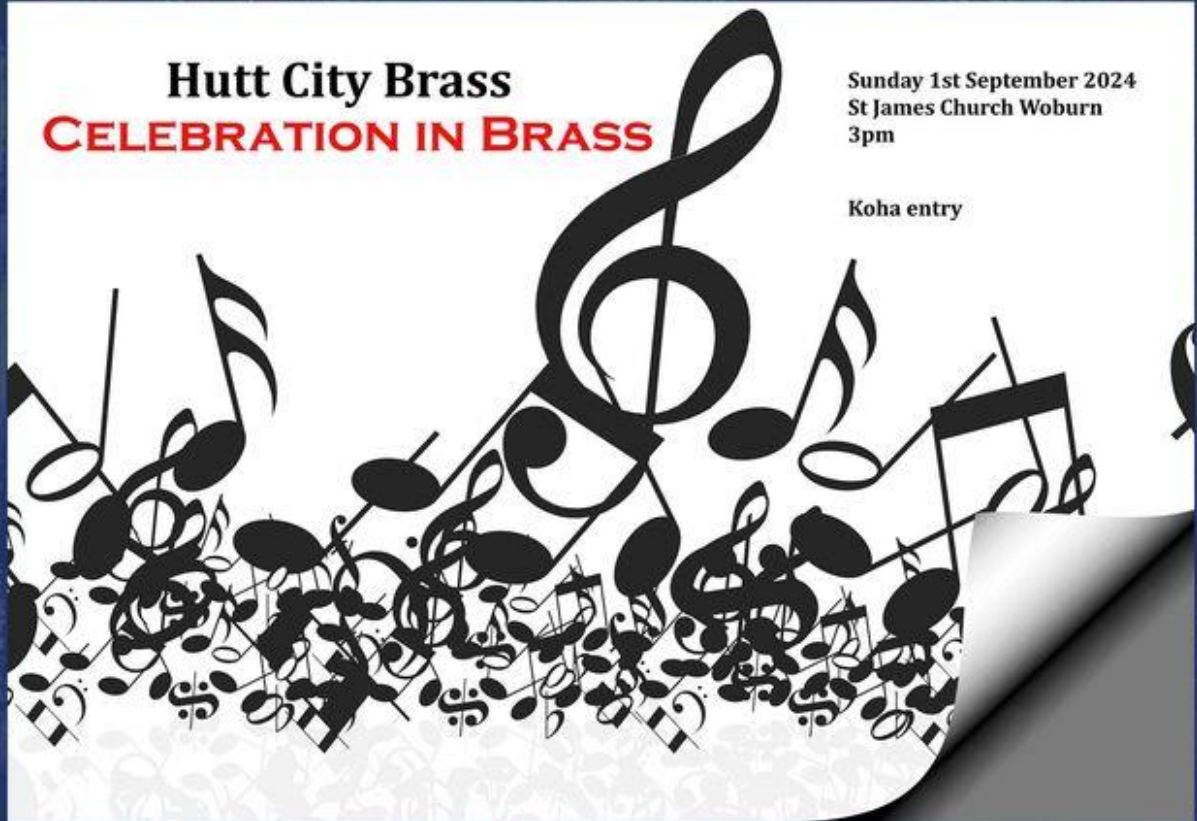

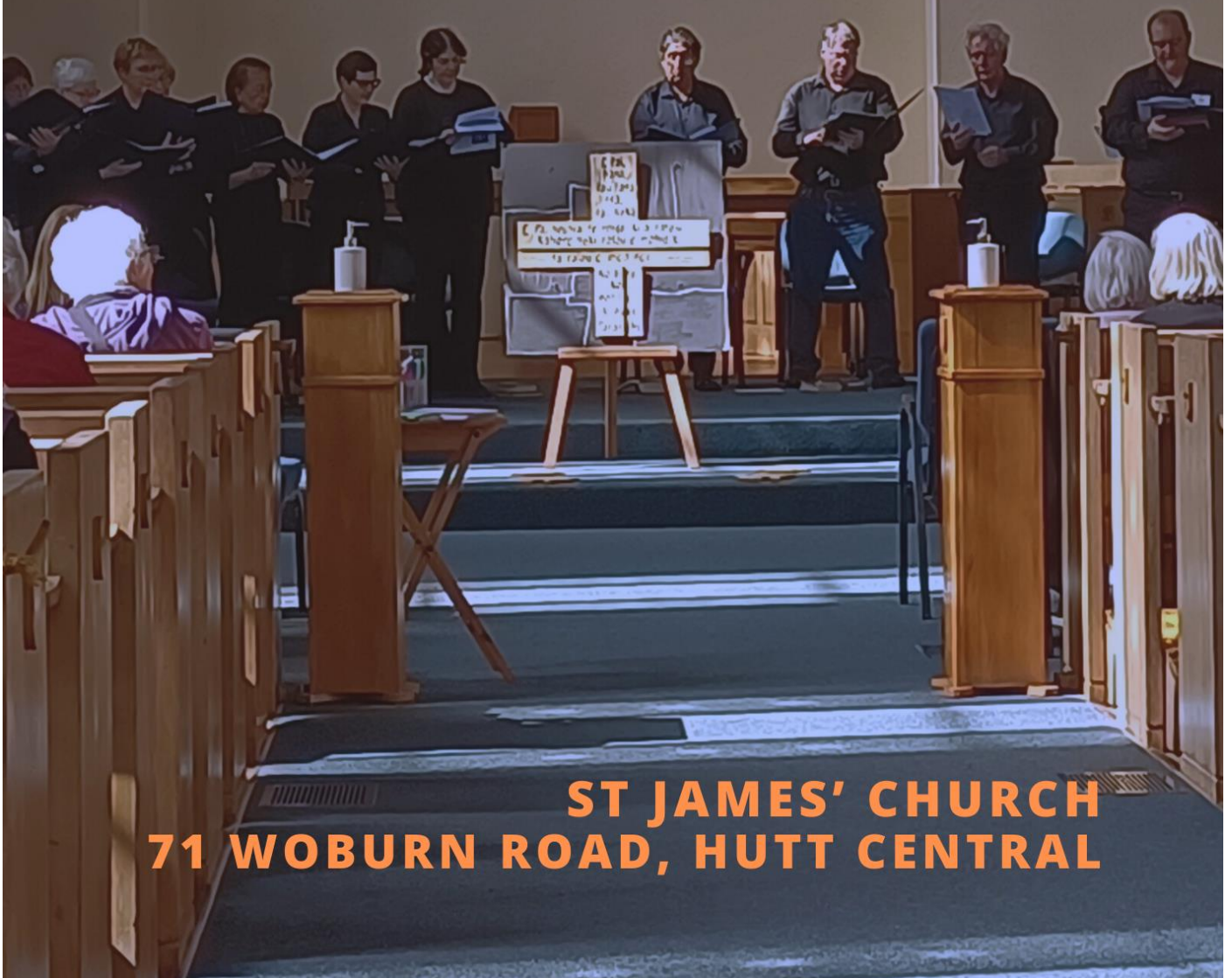

how majestic is your name in all the earth!

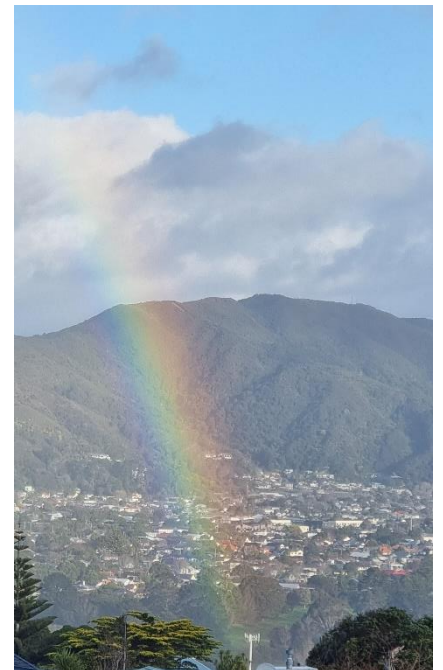
