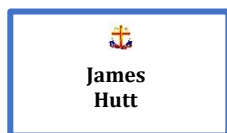

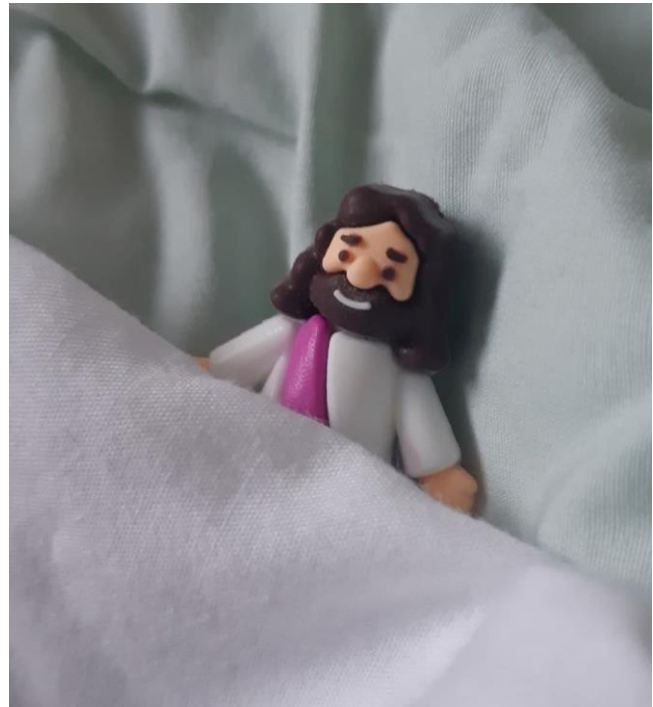

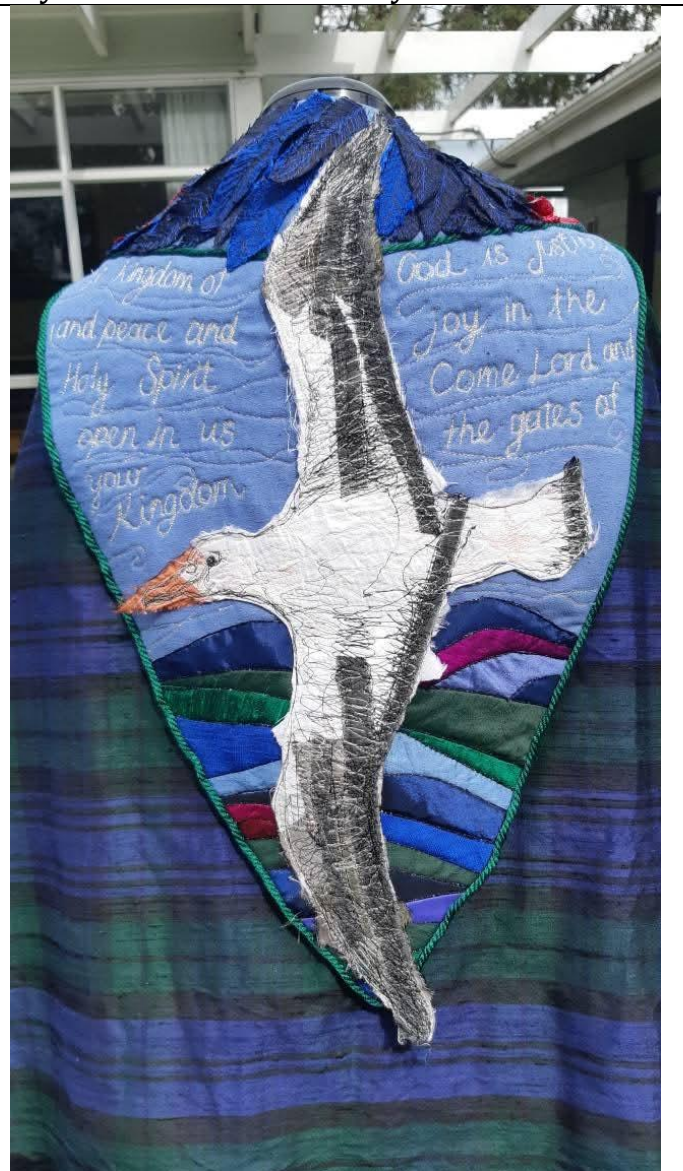
## Peace Without Limits

With the seasons changing, the Home of Compassion in Wellington is anticipating more people and families will be doing it tough.

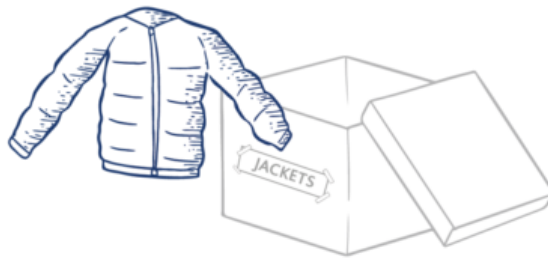
They are requesting (monetary) donations so they can purchase ingredients for their soup kitchen and clothing for their “clothing room”.

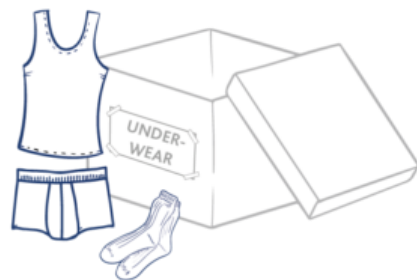
